BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Vernon College January 20, 2016

The Board of Trustees of Vernon College met on Wednesday, January 20, 2016 at 11:30 a.m. in the *Board Room* of the *Osborne Administration Building*, Vernon, Texas with the following present: Dr. Todd Smith, Chairman, Mr. Norman Brints, Vice-Chairman and Mrs. Vicki Pennington, Secretary. Other board members in attendance were Mr. Bob Ferguson, Mr. Irl Holt, and Mrs. Joanie Rogers. Absent was Mrs. Anne Spears

Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

Consent Agenda

Mrs. Pennington made the motion, seconded by Mr. Ferguson to approve the Consent Agenda containing the *Minutes of the December 16, 2015 Regular Board Meeting* and the *President's Monthly Travel Expense Report*. The motion carried unanimously.

Action Item A

Dean David presented the *Financial and Investment Reports as of December 31, 2015*. Mr. Ferguson made the motion, seconded by Mr. Holt to approve the report as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Action Item B

Mrs. Rogers made the motion, seconded by Mr. Ferguson to approve *Adopting Specific Degree Programs as Multidisciplinary Studies Associate Degree Programs as Required by Senate Bill 1189, 84th Legislative Session as presented by Dr. Johnston and Dr. Harkey. The motion carried unanimously.*

Action Item C

Mr. Brints made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Rogers to approve the *Order of Trustee Election to be Conducted May 7, 2016* as presented by Dr. Johnston. The motion carried unanimously.

Public Comment – No one was present to make comments.

President's Report/Board Discussion Items

Dr. Johnston introduced Mr. Jim Nordone, Dean of Student Services, and Mrs. Ivy Harris, ERP/SIS Coordinator.

Board Member Discussion/Input – No items were discussed.

<u>Vernon College Foundation Report</u> – Dr. Smith reported on the Vernon College Foundation Quarterly Meeting held on both the Vernon campus and Century City Center via Teleconference on January 19. This was the first meeting without Joe Chat Sumner. Mrs. Helen Willingham, Vice Chairman, assumed the role of Chairman and

conducted the meeting. Dean David presented the Financial and Investment Reports. Dr. Johnston presented his College Update. The Directors' accepted the Vernon College Foundation Annual Audit and approved the IRS 990 as presented by the Foundation's auditor, Mr. Mark Fleming of Edgin, Parkman, Fleming and Fleming. Other business included the approval a new \$20,000 grant for Dual Credit Scholarships for the 2016-2017 Academic Year and the approval of a 5% earnings spend rate for 2016-2017 scholarships. Ms. Michelle A. Alexander presented the philanthropic report.

Dr. Johnston reported that the Professional Staff Development Program held on January 11 was a successful day and enjoyed by all.

<u>ERP/SIS update</u> – Dr. Johnston provided an update on the Enterprise Resource Program/Student Information System. The ERP/SIS will replace POISE; this is the software system that runs the college. The request for proposals (RFP's) was submitted and the responses from the three companies chosen by the ERP/SIS Task Force, were received. This group has a large task of reviewing the proposals. They will make a recommendation to the President in February.

Title III Student Success Pathway update – Mrs. Harkey and Dean Nordone reported on the Title III Student Success Pathway. Mrs. Harkey stated the PowerPoint presentation, put together by Brandi Brannon and Sjohonton Fanner, in the blackboard packet, serves as a reference for the Title III Student Success Pathway activities. She also explained that the Title III grant includes two strategies: (1) provide students, faculty, staff and administration with the tools and information, such as the new ERP system, they need to make data informed decisions; and (2) increase academic support through proactive and intrusive advising. Mr. Nordone stated he is excited to take the lead from here and he feels the overall Title III grant is a great opportunity to have the tools to make informed decisions, and to keep students retained, making academic progress, and graduating from college and entering the workforce. He is working with faculty on the Mini Grant activity that is also a part of the Title III grant.

<u>Student Success Data Fact</u> – Betsy Harkey presented the Student Success Data Fact for January, which was the Key Performance Indicator of Accountability for Financial Aid.

<u>IT Management Review</u> – Dr. Johnston presented the Annual IT Management Review from Run Business Solutions. They are performing according to the plan, on time, and within budget.
