

November 2024 Update

College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston, President

- Fall Enrollment—the 12th day count for fall enrollment settled at 2284 of which 698 are dual credit high school students. This equates to a 6.43% increase in student enrollment from last fall. The headcount last fall was 2146 including 642 dual credit high school students. As we have discussed, there are many variables effecting enrollment statewide and nationwide. I will have statewide 12th day count numbers for Texas community colleges soon and I will share that information with you as soon as I receive it.
