APPLY

Apply to Vernon College at apply.vernoncollege.edu.

SUBMIT ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

Submit the following documents to be admitted as a student:

- Bacterial Meningitis shot records (unless 22 years of age or older)
- Official transcript from a prior college/university OR your high school diploma/GED certificate.

COMPLETE TESTING

Schedule to take the TSIA2 exam at our Testing Center to determine college readiness. If you meet any exemptions, submit scores/documentation to Admissions!

COMPLETE CHAPARRAL ORIENTATION

Complete Chaparral Orientation in-person or online to be prepared for college!
